

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 938.795 (1) to (4) of the statutes; **relating to:** community services.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PREFATORY NOTE: This draft was prepared for the joint legislative council’s special committee on recodification of ch. 938, the juvenile justice code. The draft proposes initial language for the recodification of subchapter XVIII, relating to community services.

2 **SECTION 1.** 938.795 (1) to (4) of the statutes are amended to read:

3 938.795 (1) COLLECT STATISTICS AND INFORMATION. Collect and collaborate with other
4 agencies in collecting statistics and information useful in determining the cause and amount
5 of delinquency and crime in this state or in carrying out the powers and duties of the
6 department [relating to delinquency and crime].

7 (2) ASSIST COMMUNITIES. Assist communities in their efforts to combat delinquency and
8 social breakdown likely to cause delinquency and crime and assist them in setting up programs
9 for coordinating ~~the a~~ total community program [relating to delinquency and crime], including
10 the improvement of law enforcement.

11 (3) ASSIST SCHOOLS. Assist schools in extending their particular contribution in ~~locating~~
12 [identifying] and helping juveniles vulnerable to delinquency and crime and in improving
13 ~~their school~~ services ~~to~~ for all youth.

14 (4) MAINTAIN PUBLIC OPINION. Develop and maintain an enlightened public opinion
15 in support of a any program to control delinquency and crime.
