We were first authorized to participate in the WI Tuition Program. It was then proposed and passed that this program be funded with gaming funds and changed to the Tribal WHEG Program. Under the tuition program, we were funded by money that other State institutions used to fund all WI students. Now that we have an approximately \$400,000.00 pot of money to share with the College of Menominee students, we have limited amount of funds with an ever increasing student population. This is the only fund that I can award to both Native American and non-Native American students. Non-Native American students comprise about 30 percent of our student population.

I have reviewed the last two years of awards to our students to determine the number of students who were eligible but were not funded by the State of Wisconsin.
