Tom Anderson Secretary Much of the discussion that has occurred in our first meetings has revolved around the appropriateness of property tax exemption, particularly for elderly housing. We thought it might be of benefit to the committee to share some information about the nature of the individuals that are occupying subsidized housing in Wisconsin. The figures in the attached reports were gathered from WHEDA, which includes not only properties in their portfolio, but also the HUD portfolio, which they administer on HUD's behalf, information from the United States Department of Agriculture – Rural Development Division Housing Programs in Stevens Point, and those of WHPC, which has over the last several of years, acquired a number of subsidized housing projects in Wisconsin.

A review of this material will show that the average income of a resident is someplace between \$8,000 - \$10,000 a year. A significant percentage of these properties are occupied by elderly people with very limited incomes, whose age is in the high 70's – low 80's. Additional rather significant, (approximately 25%) of its residence experience physical handicaps of one form or another.

Clearly, these tenants need every financial break they can receive in order to continue to live in homes that provide decent shelter and safety. It is equally clear that the owners of these properties need continuing financial support, direct or indirect, from federal, state and local government in order to be able to operate these properties with a positive cash flow. Therefore, we believe that the continuation of tax exemption or PILOT tax agreements with local municipalities is critical to the State's ability to meet its commitment to provide below county median income families with housing.

These populations, due to their physical and social needs, and the difficulties they and the elderly sometimes experience living together, add significant cost burdens to the owner.
