# Summary of Crisis Preparedness Support for Schools from the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction December 13, 2006

### Current and recent services and projects

- 1. Consultation on responding to crises available from DPI staff since 1980's.
- 2. Safe and Drug Free Schools and Communities Program funding to all 426 school districts, can include crisis preparedness and response, security personnel and equipment. Since 1987.
- 3. School Safety Planning Guidelines, included crisis response, 1997.
- 4. Regional crisis response teams at Cooperative Education Service Agencies (CESAs), funded 1998-2002. Several still active.
- 5. Consultation and training from CESA staff on school safety/violence prevention, since mid 1990's.
- 6. Forum on Youth Violence conference, 1994-2003.
- 7. Safe Schools Task Force Report and legal resources manual, with DOJ, 1999.
- 8. Bullying prevention training and technical assistance, since 1999. Includes curriculum, policy guidelines, and information resources.
- 9. Safe Schools Resources webpage, since 2000, with links to national and state resources. http://dpi.wi.gov/sspw/safeschool.html
- 10. Suicide prevention project, including crisis response, since 2001.
- 11. Pandemic Flu preparedness planning with DHFS, and communication to schools. 2006.
- 12. School Crisis Preparedness Conferences, supported by OJA; DPI is advisor, promoter. 2006
- 13. School Crisis Preparedness State Team, 2006. Interagency coordination.
- 14. Safe Schools monthly webcasts beginning 12/18/06.
