1 AN ACT to amend 115.01 (10) (a) 2. of the statutes; relating to: computation of school

days.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PREFATORY NOTE: This bill was prepared for the Joint Legislative Council's Special Committee on Emergency Management and Continuity of Government.

Current law provides that no state aid may be paid to a school district that fails to hold school for at least 180 days each year, with the days to be computed in accordance with s. 115.01 (10). That latter statute provides that school days are days on which school is actually taught and also include the following: (1) days on which school is closed by order of the school district administrator because of inclement weather and days on which parent—teacher conferences are held, not to exceed 5 days during the school term; and (2) days on which school is closed by order of a local health officer. This bill also includes days on which school is closed by order of the state department of health services.

- 4 115.01 (10) (a) 2. Days on which school is closed by order of a local health officer, as
- 5 defined in s. 250.01 (5), or the department of health services.
