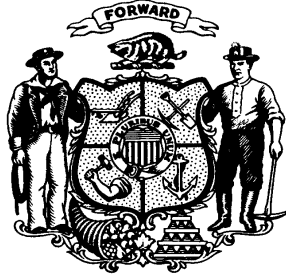

5. WLC: 0379/1, relating to creating rebuttable presumption in waiver proceedings, passed by a vote of Ayes, 9 (Carpenter, Grigsby, Dickey, Franks, Henderson, Lee, Malmstadt, Mertens, and Moore); and Noes, 4 (Zipperer, Roth, Hasting, and Schimel).
