Dear Senator Robson:

Please find enclosed the results of the Department of Health Services' data gathering and analysis for the Legislative Council Special Committee on Infant Mortality. The following items are enclosed:

Wisconsin Births and Infant Deaths: These are the most recent data (2008) on births and infant deaths in Dane, Kenosha, Milwaukee, Racine, and Rock counties. In 2008, 94% of births to African American mothers, and 92% of African American infant deaths occurred in Dane, Kenosha, Milwaukee, Racine, and Rock counties. Almost half of all Wisconsin infant deaths occurred in these same 5 counties.

Wisconsin Facts: Racial and Ethnic Disparities in Infant Mortality (January 2010) This fact sheet provides a number of key factors on infant death by race and ethnicity, statewide, using the most recent Wisconsin linked birth and infant death data from 2008.

DHS Response: Data Request from the Legislative Council Special Committee on Infant Mortality: This document and its attached tables include the most recent data available in answer to the questions enclosed with your letter of September 28, 2010.
