- LRB-1326/1, relating to filing a statement of reasons when a judge or justice denies a motion for disqualification, failed by a vote of Ayes, 6; Noes, 10; and Absent, 6.
- LRB-1327/1, relating to temporary service by a court of appeals judge in the supreme court in judicial disciplinary proceedings (first consideration), failed by a vote of Ayes, 6; Noes, 10; and Absent, 6.

Any member of the Joint Legislative Council and the Special Committee may circulate a petition to have this matter reconsidered. Reconsideration requires the signatures of 12 members of the Joint Legislative Council. In addition, any individual legislator may introduce this legislation.
