#### Why Serve as a Public Member of a Legislative Council Study Committee?

The study committees provide a unique opportunity for the public to become directly involved in the formulation of public policy. Public members not only participate in meetings, lending their perspective on the issues, they vote on the proposals intended to resolve these issues. Although public members are not paid for their participation on the study committees, they are entitled to receive reimbursement for certain travel expenses, including mileage, parking, meals, and overnight stays, if necessary.
