Fostering System Improvements & Quality Services

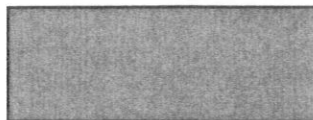
WAFCA promotes the development of efficient and cost-effective human services by encouraging best practices and supporting the transfer of research to service delivery.

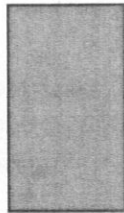
