SUBJECT: Overview of SAGE Funding and School District Participation

This memorandum provides information on state funding for the SAGE program and the general fund budget as well as information on school district participation in the program.

The SAGE program is funded with general purpose revenue (GPR) from the state's general fund. To put program funding in context, Attachment 1 shows the largest appropriations from the general fund in 2014-15. In that year, 32.4% of the general fund is appropriated for school aids, and an additional 5.6% of the general fund is appropriated for the school levy and first dollar tax credits, which reduce the gross school property tax levy.

Attachment 2 presents more detail on 2014-15 general fund appropriations, by spending purpose. In the state's budget, funding is provided for local assistance, state operations, and aids to individuals and organizations. As shown in Attachment 2, elementary and secondary school aids represent 63.7% of all funding for local assistance programs, and 32.4% of the general fund budget in 2014-15.

Attachment 3 shows more detail on state funding for school aids in the 2013-15 biennium. Each appropriation for school aids is presented along with its base level of funding in 2012-13, annual funding in 2013-14 and 2014-15, as well as the 2013-15 change to the base year doubled. As shown in Attachment 3, most GPR funding categorical aid appropriations, including the SAGE appropriation, were level funded in the 2013-15 biennium, with annual funding remaining at the 2012-13 amount in 2013-14 and 2014-15.

Attachment 4 focuses on just the GPR categorical aid appropriations in 2014-15. The appropriations are displayed by amount of funding. The main appropriation for special education is the largest categorical aid appropriation, representing 52.6% of all GPR categorical aid funding in

that year. Per pupil aid is the second largest categorical aid appropriation with 18.1% of all categorical aid funding, followed by the SAGE appropriation with 15.6% of the total.

Attachment 5 shows school district participation in the SAGE program since 1996-97. For each year, Attachment 5 presents the number of school districts, school buildings, FTE pupils, and the aid amount.

Attachment 6 shows the number of pupils receiving free and reduced price lunch for each school building participating in the SAGE program. In addition, total enrollment, the number of low-income SAGE pupils, and the amount of SAGE funding is presented.

Attachment 7 shows participation data for the free and reduced price lunch program for non-SAGE schools with elementary grades.
