## Overview of Survey

- Distributed to 53 district administrators with at least one school meeting the following requirements:
  - At least one grade in K-3,
  - At least 50% of the student population eligible for free or reduced price lunch, and
  - Not a current participant in SAGE.
- □ Survey collection ran from September 5 -12

- Questions related to four main areas:
  - Considerations preventing schools from participating in SAGE,
  - Future participation in SAGE,
  - Non-SAGE curricula and interventions, and
  - Non-SAGE class size.



### How many districts responded?


#### Survey Response Rates by Urban or Rural Location and Overall

Location	Number Surveyed	Number Responded	Percent Responded
Urban	20	5	25%
Rural	33	13	39%
Total	53	18	34%


#### Considerations Preventing Schools from Participating in SAGE





## Would schools consider enrolling in SAGE if a new round of contracts were authorized?


#### Consideration of Enrollment

Changes to SAGE that Would Make Participation More Likely






## How much per economically disadvantaged pupil would allow schools to participate?
