

## **Impact of Eliminating the Personal Property Tax on Select Municipalities**

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### Village of Saukville, 60<sup>th</sup> Assembly District

1. Personal property represents 4% percent of Village of Saukville's total equalized value (including computers).
2. Personal property will generate \$115,006 in taxes during 2014 to fund local services. (just Village of Saukville's mill rate per CW)
3. Personal property represents 0 percent of Village of Saukville's total TID increment (including computers).
4. Personal property will generate \$0 in TID increment during 2014 to pay back TID bonding.

### City of Eagle River, 12th Senate District

1. Personal property represents 7 percent of City of Eagle River's total equalized value (including computers).
2. Personal property will generate \$86,973.06 in taxes during 2014 to fund local services.
3. Personal property represents 5 percent of the City of Eagle River's total TID increment (including computers).
4. Personal property will generate \$11,647.00 in TID increment during 2014 to pay back TID bonding.

### City of LaCrosse, 32<sup>nd</sup> Senate District

1. Personal property represents 8.16% percent of the City of La Crosse's total equalized value (including computers).
2. Personal property will generate \$5,859,132 in taxes during 2014 to fund local services.
3. Personal property represents 18.4 percent of the City of La Crosse's total TID increment (including computers).
4. Personal property will generate \$1,332,920 in TID increment during 2014 to pay back TID bonding.

### City of Marshfield, 69<sup>th</sup> Assembly District

1. Personal property represents 8.69% percent of the City of Marshfield's total equalized value (including computers).
2. Personal property will generate \$ 1,632,426 in taxes during 2014 to fund local services.
3. Personal property represents 9% percent of the City of Marshfield's total TID increment (including computers).
4. Personal property will generate \$221,140 in TID increment during 2014 to pay back TID bonding.

City of Monona, 47<sup>th</sup> Assembly District

1. Personal property represents 2.8 percent of the City of Monona's total equalized value (including computers).
2. Personal property will generate \$741,234 in taxes during 2014 to fund local services.
3. Personal property represents 1 percent of the City of Monona's total TID increment (including computers).
4. Personal property will generate \$ 2,972 in TID increment during 2014 to pay back TID bonding.

City of River Falls, 10<sup>th</sup> Senate District

1. Personal property represents 2.2 percent of City of River Falls' total equalized value (including computers).
2. Personal property will generate \$404,322 in taxes during 2014 to fund local services (includes county, school district, tech college and City).
3. Personal property represents 6 percent of City of River Falls' total TID increment (including computers).
4. Personal property will generate \$58,000 in TID increment during 2014 to pay back TID bonding.
