The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PREFATORY NOTE: This draft was prepared for the Joint Legislative Council's Special Committee on State-Tribal Relations. Under current law, a school district may contract with another entity to operate a charter school within the district. The process may be commenced by a petition by the teachers of a school or of the district or on the school board's own initiative. If approved, the proposed charter school is established by a contract between the school board and the charter school operator. In addition, the common council of the city of Milwaukee, the chancellor of the University of Wisconsin (UW)-Milwaukee, the chancellor of the UW-Parkside, and the Milwaukee area technical college district board may initiate a contract for the operation of a charter school. This draft authorizes the College of the Menominee Nation and the Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwa Community College, the 2 tribal colleges in this state, to initiate a contract for the operation of a charter school.
