2017 BILL

1 **AN ACT to amend** 938.32 (5) (title) of the statutes; **relating to:** recusal from
2 juvenile justice proceedings (suggested as remedial legislation by the State
3 Public Defender).

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill amends the title of a statutory section that addresses when a judge must recuse himself or herself from further juvenile justice proceedings from “refusal” to “recusal,” which is a more accurate legal description of the process.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

LAW REVISION COMMITTEE PREFATORY NOTE: This bill is a remedial legislation proposal, requested by the State Public Defender and introduced by the Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., stats. After careful consideration of the various provisions of the bill, the Law Revision Committee has determined that this bill makes minor substantive changes in the statutes, and that these changes are desirable as a matter of public policy.

4 **SECTION 1.** 938.32 (5) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 938.32 (5) (title) ~~REFUSAL~~ RECUSAL FROM SUBSEQUENT PROCEEDINGS.
