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


# States looking beyond federal requirements

# State Dyslexia Policy




■ Statute and/or regulation specific to dyslexia

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
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
# New Jersey Dyslexia Policy



# New Hampshire Dyslexia Policy







- Outlines a definition and characteristics of dyslexia
- Provides research on dyslexia
- Provides screening, monitoring, and evaluation resources and practices
- Outlines a range of instructional strategies for teachers
- Provides examples of accommodations for students with dyslexia
- Information for parents

## **Tennessee Guidebook**

- Serves as a procedural guide for teachers and schools
- Provides resources and procedures for screening, intervention, progress monitoring, and reporting
- Provides guidance on how to evaluate a student's need for special education services
- Outlines professional development to improve instruction and awareness
