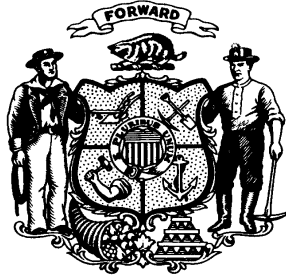

The Joint Legislative Council voted to introduce the following bill draft, which was recommended by the Study Committee on the Identification and Management of Dyslexia:

1. **LRB-0368/2**, relating to employing a dyslexia specialist at the Department of Public Instruction and making an appropriation.

The motion to introduce the bill draft passed by a vote of Ayes, 12 (Sens. Roth, Fitzgerald, Jacque, Marklein, and Olsen; and Reps. Brooks, August, Ballweg, Nygren, Spiros, Steineke, and Vos); Noes, 8 (Sens. Erpenbach, Miller, Risser, and Shilling; and Reps. Billings, Hesselbein, Hintz, and Taylor); and Absent, 2 (Sens. Darling and Petrowski).

Co-Chair Roth deferred the vote on LRB-0383/3 until the March 6, 2019 meeting of the Joint Legislative Council.
