## PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

1 AN ACT to create 115.28 (56) of the statutes; relating to: model academic

standards for American Indian studies.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the state superintendent of public instruction, in consultation with the Wisconsin Indian Education Association, to develop model academic standards for American Indian studies. Under the bill, the model academic standards for American Indian studies must include an expectation that pupils know historical and contemporary information about American Indian tribes and bands, including information on tribal sovereignty, culture, and significant events.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**Section 1.** 115.28 (56) of the statutes is created to read:

115.28 **(56)** American Indian Studies; model academic standards. In consultation with Wisconsin Indian Education Association, Inc., develop model academic standards for American Indian studies under which pupils are expected to know contemporary and historical information related to at least all of the following:
