## 2019 BILL

AN ACT to amend 41.11 (1) (h) of the statutes; relating to: the reporting duties of the Department of Tourism (suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Tourism).

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Tourism is required to annually report on its activities to the Senate Natural Resources Committee and the Assembly Committee on Tourism. This bill modifies the requirement so that the department reports to the appropriate standing committees of the legislature.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Law Revision Committee prefatory note: This bill is a remedial legislation proposal, requested by the Department of Tourism and introduced by the Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., stats. After careful consideration of the various provisions of the bill, the Law Revision Committee has determined that this bill makes minor substantive changes in the statutes, and that these changes are desirable as a matter of public policy.

SECTION 1. 41.11 (1) (h) of the statutes is amended to read:

## BILL

41.11 (1) (h) Annually report to the senate natural resources committee and the assembly committee on tourism appropriate standing committees of the legislature under s. 13.172 (3) the activities, marketing efforts, receipts, and disbursements of the department for the previous fiscal year. The report under this paragraph shall include information on the marketing efforts conducted for the Frank Lloyd Wright Trail established under s. 84.10255.

Note: Section 1 requires the Department of Tourism to make its annual report to "appropriate" legislative standing committees, rather than to specifically named committees.
