2019 BILL

1 **AN ACT to amend** 48.545 (2) (a) (intro.) of the statutes; **relating to:** sources of
2 funding for the Brighter Futures Initiative (suggested as remedial legislation
3 by the Department of Children and Families).

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill changes the appropriations from which amounts are distributed for awarding grants under the Brighter Futures Initiative. Under that program, the Department of Children and Families awards grants to nonprofit corporations and public agencies to provide programs to, among other things, prevent and reduce the incidence of youth alcohol and other drug abuse.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

LAW REVISION COMMITTEE PREFATORY NOTE: This bill is a remedial legislation proposal, requested by the Department of Children and Families and introduced by the Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., stats. After careful consideration of the various provisions of the bill, the Law Revision Committee has determined that this bill makes minor substantive changes in the statutes, and that these changes are desirable as a matter of public policy.

4 **SECTION 1.** 48.545 (2) (a) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 48.545 **(2)** (a) (intro.) From the appropriations under s. 20.437 (1) (eg), (kb),
2 ~~(ky)~~, and ~~(nL)~~ (2) (md), the department, subject to par. (am), shall distribute
3 \$2,097,700 in each fiscal year to applying nonprofit corporations and public agencies
4 operating in a county having a population of 750,000 or more, \$1,171,800 in each
5 fiscal year to applying county departments under s. 46.22, 46.23, 51.42, or 51.437
6 operating in counties other than a county having a population of 750,000 or more,
7 and \$55,000 in each fiscal year to Diverse and Resilient, Inc. to provide programs to
8 accomplish all of the following:

NOTE: This SECTION changes the appropriations used to fund Brighter Futures Initiative grants. It deletes a reference to a federal program local assistance appropriation and adds references to appropriations for interagency and intra-agency local assistance aids and federal block grant aids.
