1 AN ACT *to create* 440.08 (2) (am) of the statutes; **relating to:** renewals of
2 credentials issued by the Department of Safety and Professional Services and
3 credentialing boards (suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of
4 Safety and Professional Services).

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, most credentials issued by the Department of Safety and Professional Services and the credentialing boards in DSPS are subject to periodic renewal. Current law also generally provides that when a licensee has made timely and sufficient application for the renewal of a credential, the credential does not expire until the application has been finally acted upon by the agency.

This bill clarifies, for purposes of a renewal of a credential issued by DSPS or a credentialing board in DSPS, that an applicant has made timely and sufficient application for the renewal until only when the applicant has submitted all forms and other documentation required for the renewal of that credential.
