PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

AN ACT to amend 46.29 (1) (a), 46.29 (1) (b), 46.29 (1) (c), 46.29 (1) (d), 46.29 (1) (e), 46.29 (1) (em), 46.29 (1) (fm), 46.29 (2) (a) and 46.29 (2) (c) of the statutes; relating to: person-first terminology related to the council on physical disabilities (suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Health Services).

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill amends statutory terminology for the Council on Physical Disabilities from "physically disabled persons" to "persons with physical disabilities".

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Law Revision Committee Prefatory Note: This bill is a remedial legislation proposal, requested by the Department of Health Services and introduced by the Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., stats. After careful consideration of the various provisions of the bill, the Law Revision Committee has determined that this bill makes changes to statutes or session laws that the Law Revision Committee determined to be in need of revision.

2	46.29 (1) (a) Develop, approve and continue modification of a state plan, for
3	services to physically disabled persons with physical disabilities, that encompasses
4	services from the entities specified under sub. (3).

5	Section 2. 46.29 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
6	46.29 (1) (b) Request reports or other information from the entities specified
7	under sub. (3) concerning programs, funding, clients or services as they relate to
8	physically disabled persons with physical disabilities.
9	Section 3. 46.29 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:
10	46.29 (1) (c) Advise the secretary of the department and make
11	recommendations, including recommendations for legislation, to the entities
12	specified under sub. (3) concerning funding, programs, policies and operations of
13	those entities and other matters with respect to physically disabled persons with
14	physical disabilities.
15	Section 4. 46.29 (1) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:
16	46.29 (1) (d) Encourage public understanding of the needs of and issues
17	concerning physically disabled persons with physical disabilities.
18	Section 5. 46.29 (1) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:
19	46.29 (1) (e) Consider all questions and matters concerning physically disabled
20	persons with physical disabilities arising within the council or brought to the council
21	for review.
22	Section 6. 46.29 (1) (em) of the statutes is amended to read:

46.29 (1) (em) Approve educational material relating to the parking privileges	
of physically disabled persons with physical disabilities for placement on vehicles as	
provided in s. 346.94 (4). The council may delegate to a member of the council or an	
officer or employee of a state agency the authority granted under this paragraph.	
Section 7. 46.29 (1) (fm) of the statutes is amended to read:	
46.29 (1) (fm) By April 15, 1996, and biennially thereafter, submit a report to	
the legislature under s. 13.172 (2) concerning the time limitations imposed by any	
ordinances enacted under s. 346.50 (3m) on spaces reserved for use by a motor vehicle	
used by a physically disabled person with a physical disability, including any	
recommended changes to s. 346.50 (3m) and copies of any reports submitted from	
cities as required by s. 346.50 (3m) (b) 5.	
SECTION 8. 46.29 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:	
46.29 (2) (a) Report to the public concerning needs of physically disabled	
persons with physical disabilities and issues that affect those persons.	
SECTION 9. 46.29 (2) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:	
46.29 (2) (c) Form committees for consideration of policies or programs for	
physically disabled persons with physical disabilities.
