PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 106.27 (1r) of the statutes; **relating to:** student internship
2 coordination (suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of
3 Workforce Development).

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law allows the Department of Workforce Development to fund the administration of certain workforce development programs from a biennial, general purpose revenue appropriation, including the program known as "Fast Forward." Current law also requires DWD, under the Fast Forward program, to provide coordination between nonprofit organizations and institutions of higher education. This bill clarifies that DWD may use moneys from this biennial appropriation for these coordination activities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 106.27 (1r) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 106.27 (1r) STUDENT INTERNSHIP COORDINATION. From the appropriation
6 appropriations under s. 20.445 (1) (b) and (bm), the department shall provide

1 coordination between nonprofit organizations and institutions of higher education,
2 as defined in 20 USC 1001 (a) and (b), and employers to increase the number of
3 students who are placed with employers for internships.

NOTE: Section 1. allows the Department of Workforce Development to use funds from its biennial appropriation for administering programs, including the Fast Forward program, for coordination efforts between nonprofit organizations and institutions of higher learning, as required under the Fast Forward program.
