## **PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION**

AN ACT to repeal 16.995, 20.505 (4) (ha), 20.505 (4) (hb), 20.866 (2) (zc) and 20.866 (2) (zcm); and to amend 20.505 (4) (es), 20.505 (4) (et), 20.505 (4) (mp) and 20.866 (1) (u) of the statutes; relating to: repealing educational technology infrastructure assistance provisions (suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Administration).

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill repeals obsolete statutory provisions related to the educational technology infrastructure program administered by the Department of Administration.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

LAW REVISION COMMITTEE PREFATORY NOTE: This bill is a remedial legislation proposal, requested by the Department of Administration and introduced by the Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., stats. After careful consideration of the various provisions of the bill, the Law Revision Committee has determined that this bill makes minor substantive changes in the statutes, and that these changes are desirable as a matter of public policy.

1	<b>SECTION 1.</b> 16.995 of the statutes is repealed.
	NOTE: This SECTION repeals an obsolete statute referring to the Educational Technology Infrastructure Program, which no longer exists.

13	public library boards. A sum sufficient to reimburse s. $20.866(1)(u)$ for the payment
14	of principal and interest costs incurred in financing educational technology
15	infrastructure financial assistance to public library boards under s. 16.995, $2019$
16	stats., to make full payment of the amounts determined by the building commission
17	under s. 13.488 (1) (m), to the extent that these costs and payments are not paid
18	under par. (hb), and to make payments under an agreement or ancillary
19	arrangement entered into under s. 18.06 (8) (a).
20	<b>SECTION 4.</b> 20.505 (4) (ha) of the statutes is repealed.
