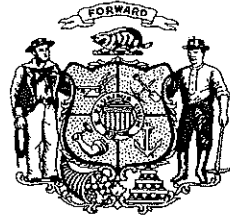

Dear Mr. Queensland and Mr. Blazel:

This report is transmitted as required by s. 20.002(11)(f), Wisconsin Statutes, (for distribution to the appropriate standing committees under s. 13.172(3), Wisconsin Statutes) and confirms that the Department of Administration has found it necessary to exercise the "temporary reallocation of balances" authority provided by this section in order to meet payment responsibilities and cover resulting negative cash balances during the month of March 2023. The source of the Interfund Borrowing coverage is the Budget Stabilization Fund.

On March 1, 2023, the **Police and Fire Protection Fund** cash balance closed at a negative \$689 thousand. The cash balance was negative until March 17, 2023, when it closed at a positive \$124 thousand. On March 9, 2023, the cash balance closed at a negative \$709 thousand (its intramonth low).

The Police and Fire Protection Fund shortfall was due to the difference in the timing of revenues and expenditures. The shortfalls were not in excess of the statutory interfund borrowing limitations and did not exceed the balances of the funds available for interfund borrowing.

The distribution of interest earnings to investment pool participants is based on the average daily balance in the pool and each fund's share. Therefore, the monthly calculation by the State Controller's Office will automatically reflect the use of these temporary reallocations of balance authority, and as a result, the funds requiring the use of the authority will effectively bear the interest cost.
