The Department of Military Affairs requests a one-time supplement of \$2,400,000 SEG in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$288,800 SEG in fiscal year 2020-21 from the Committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(u) to the department's state disaster assistance; petroleum inspection fund appropriation under s. 20.465(3)(s) to pay claims submitted by local units of government for damages and costs incurred as a result of a disaster.

II. <u>Department of Natural Resources</u> – Preston Cole, Secretary

The Department of Natural Resources requests a supplement of \$487,300 SEG in fiscal year 2019-20 from the Committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(u) to the department's hydrologic evaluation and modeling appropriation under s. 20.370(4)(cr) for the purpose of completing a hydrologic study required under 2017 Wisconsin Act 10.

#### III. <u>Department of Natural Resources</u> – Preston Cole, Secretary

The Department of Natural Resources requests the transfer of \$677,800 SEG in fiscal year 2019-20 from the department's forestry – forestry emergency reserve appropriation under s. 20.370(2)(cv) to the department's general program operations – state funds; forestry appropriation under s. 20.370(2)(mv) to cover costs incurred by the department while responding to a significant storm event in July 2019. The Department of Natural Resources also requests the transfer of \$489,100 in fiscal year 2019-20 from the department's forestry – forestry emergency reserve appropriation under s. 20.370(2)(cv) to the department's resource aids - urban forestry grants appropriation under s. 20.370(5)(az) to provide storm response grants that have been requested by communities impacted by the storms.

#### IV. Department of Natural Resources – Preston Cole, Secretary

The Department of Natural Resources requested approval of a \$406,712 Knowles-Nelson Stewardship grant to The Nature Conservancy for the acquisition of 107 acres in Walworth County, to connect isolated parcels of land in the Crooked Creek Preserve.

The Department of Tourism requests a supplement of \$65,200 GPR in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$23,700 GPR in fiscal year 2020-21 from the Committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(a) to the department's state aid for the arts appropriation under s. 20.380(3)(b) to meet the federal grant awarded by the National Endowment for the Arts.
