II. PROPOSED RULE

SECTION 1. DHS 12.03 (22) (a) is amended to read.

"Treatment foster home" means a family-oriented facility-operated by a person or persons required to be licensed under s. 48.62 (1) (b), Stats., in which treatment, care and maintenance are provided for no more than 4 foster children.

SECTION 2. DHS 12.03 (22) (note) is repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, as provided in s. 227.22 (2), Stats.
