

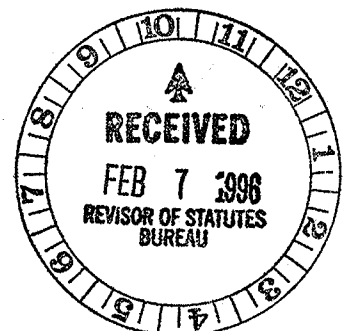

**ORDER OF THE
STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION
REPEALING RULES**

The state superintendent of public instruction hereby repeals chapters PI 17, PI 24, PI 27, PI 28, PI 30, PI 31, PI 34, PI 36, PI 37 and PI 38, relating to the elimination of obsolete rules.

ANALYSIS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION

Statutory authority: ss. 227.11(2)(a) and 227.16(2)(a) and (b), Stats.

Statute interpreted: See analysis

The following chapters have been repealed due to the elimination or modification of statutory programs as follows:

Chapter PI 17, relating to the vocational education instructor occupational competency program. This chapter is repealed since the program is no longer required by statute to be jointly implemented by both the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) and the department. Current statutes, s. 38.32, Stats., require the program to be implemented by the WTCS only.

Chapter PI 24, relating to the teaching incentives program. Originally developed to implement the teaching incentives program established under s. 115.40, Stats., this chapter is repealed since the program has been eliminated in statute.

Chapter PI 27, relating to grants to strengthen family life. Originally developed to implement grants to strengthen family life as a result of nonstatutory provisions to 1987 Wisconsin act 27, this chapter is repealed since the program has been eliminated in statute.

Chapter PI 28, relating to the morning milk program. Originally developed to provide payment to participating schools for reduced price beverages served to eligible pupils if any funds remained after payment was made to schools for free beverages served to eligible pupils, this chapter is repealed since the statutory language was modified in 1991 Wisconsin Act 39. The Act modified s. 115.343, Stats., to allow payment for milk served to free and reduced-price eligible pupils and eliminated the requirement that administrative rules be developed.

Chapter PI 30, relating to learning assistance programs. This chapter is repealed due to the elimination of s. 115.363, Stats., the learning assistance program, under 1995 Wisconsin Act 27.

Chapter PI 31, relating to science, mathematics and technology education grants. This chapter is repealed due to the elimination of s. 115.392, Stats., the science, mathematics and technology education grant program, under 1995 Wisconsin Act 27.

Chapter PI 34, relating to the home school coordinator program. This chapter is repealed due to the elimination of s. 115.745, Stats., the home school coordinator program, under 1995 Wisconsin Act 27.

Chapter PI 36, relating to the management restructuring program. This chapter is repealed due to the elimination of s. 118.013, Stats., the management restructuring program, under 1995 Wisconsin Act 49.

Chapter PI 37, relating to elementary mathematics and science programs. This chapter is repealed due to the elimination of s. 115.364, Stats., the elementary mathematics and science programs, under 1995 Wisconsin Act 27.

Chapter PI 38, relating to the staff development grant program. This chapter is repealed due to the elimination of s. 115.366, Stats., the staff development grant program, under 1995 Wisconsin Act 27.


The elimination of these chapters is technical. In most cases, statutes no longer exist for the rule to interpret or implement. Therefore, pursuant to s. 227.16(2)(a) and (b), Stats., the department will not hold public hearings regarding these rules.

The department no longer collects information, requires data, or distributes funds that are affected by these rule chapters. Therefore, an initial applicability clause is not necessary.

 - SECTION 10. Chapter PI 38 is repealed.

The rules contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month commencing after the date of publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register, as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
