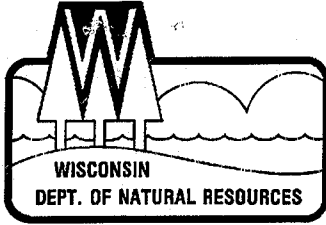

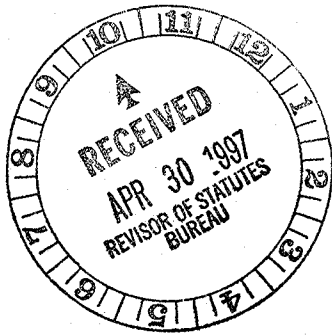

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
CREATING RULES

The State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board proposes an order to create NR 5.21(2) relating to waiver of the slow-no-wake speed restriction on the Wild Rose Mill Pond, Waushara County

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 30.635 and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 30.635, Stats.

On August 20, 1996, the Department of Natural Resources received a petition from the village of Wild Rose, Waushara county for waiver of the slow-no-wake speed restriction on Wild Rose mill pond. Section 30.635, Stats., provides that on lakes 50 acres or less having public access, motorboats may not be operated in excess of slow-no-wake speed. Wild Rose mill pond is 17 acres. The proposed rule would allow the use of motorboats on Wild Rose mill pond for a special fund raising event the last full weekend in June of each year.

SECTION 1. NR 5.21(2) is created to read:

NR 5.21(2) The slow-no-wake speed restriction is waived on the waters of Wild Rose mill pond, located in the village of Wild Rose, Waushara county, the last full weekend in June of each year.

The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on February 26, 1997.

The rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.

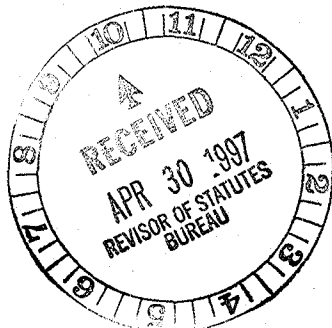

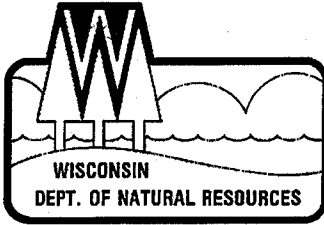
